 Were no visible aboriginal sites in the areas we covered,
 And or none previously recorded due to very limited
 Archaeology surveys in that particular area.

Albeit Bill, there are quiet a number of recorded sites in
 The Yarram area and particualy on the southern side of
 The South Gippsland Highway.

The proposed construction area is surrounded by creeks
 And valley,s , with good high escarpment,t for travelling
 Routes and viewing the countryside, so it would not
 Surprise me to find sites after construction begins or an
 Archaeological survey takes place.

Whatever the outcome, all ground disturbance, roads
 Heavy machinery movement, utilities (power, gas, phone
 Ect,ect should be monitored by an experienced aboriginal
 Community monitor.
